GETTING THERE

The entrance to Rotoiti Lake House is via a private forestry road (Tumoana Road) which is directly off SH 30.

Heading from Rotorua it is approximately 2 km's past the popular tourist attraction 'Hells Gate" (If you start going down a very long incline with a passing lane on the opposite side of the road - you have gone too far).

Approaching from the East it is approximately 500 metres past the top of a very long passing lane (if you drive past "Hell's Gate" you have gone too far).

Once on the Road, you just need to veer left and follow the signs for Tumoana Road. 171 is in the first group of houses you will come across.

There is no boat launching off the front of the property or is there anywhere to easily to turn your boat. So please **DO NOT** tow your boat down the driveway and instead leave it (or just the trailer after launching) at the empty section adjoining Tumoana Road.



LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

MANUPIRUA HOT POOLS

Manupirua Hot Pools are accessibly only by water, and a charge applies to use them.

They are approximately only 10 mins by boat (jetty to jetty) or approximately a 2000 metre paddle/row from Rotoiti Lake House (you will need to drag your watercraft across a very narrow sand bar to shorten drastically the trip).

NATURAL HOT POOLS

This private and traditional hot water pool is approximately an easy 15 walk from the Lake House

- Walk up the drive and turn to your right.
- Follow the Tumoana Road until you get to the first chained off parking area.
- Enter the parking area and follow the track/path for 400m or so (via right).
- You'll eventually get to a straightening that often has some residual water in the middle of it.
- At the end of the straightening you'll see another large turning area for trucks.
- The path then turns and keeps going right. Stop at this turn.
- You should be able to hear the noise of a waterfall flowing.
- Orientate yourself so your back is against the noise of the waterfall.
- You will be able to see in front of you, on the other side of the track, a gap between the bushes that leads to a path that runs along a hot water creek.
- Follow this path along the side of the creek until you can see a large rock at the end of the path. The rock contains the hot water pool.
- There is a lower larger shallower pool (the sand can be quite hot if you dig into it) and a smaller, deeper pool accessible if you climb up the rock (there are toe holes cut into the rock to enable this!).
- The top pool holds a couple of adults or an adult and two to three children at a squeeze.

BOAT/TRAILER PARKING

There is no room to turn a boat/trailer at the house, and no where to launch it.

If you have a boat you will need to launch at either at the boat ramp at the end of Tumoana Road, or at an alternative one, and tow your trailer to the top of the drive where there is an empty section where it can be stored.

There is a jetty immediately at the front of the property which is shared between the neighbouring properties and Rotoiti Lake House which you may also use for your boat.

Please be respectful of our neighbours jetty requirements though if you have visitors during the day also wishing to use the jetty.
